

## Asbestos Risk Calculator

Safety in Numbers contains a number of calculators. The Asbestos Risk Calculator asks 7 questions and provides guidance on the level of risk that the asbestos material may pose and what actions should be taken. This can be more frequent inspections, repair or abate in the near term or immediate corrective action. The calculator walks you through the questions. You simply click on the option that best describes your situation. An example of the printout from the calculator is provided below.

**ASBESTOS RISK CALCULATOR**

**Extent of Damage:** medium: significant breakage or several small areas revealing loose asbestos fibres

**Location:** large room or well ventilated area

**Product Type:** pipe and boiler insulation

**Asbestos Content:** 2 - 25% or if content is unknown

**Number of Occupants:** 1 to 3

**Frequency of Occupancy:** weekly

**Duration of Occupancy:** 1 to 3 hours

**Action to take**

- Regular annual inspection
- More Frequent Inspections
- Near Term Corrective Action**
- Immediate Corrective Action
