
Possible ACM found in Buildings





- Roof felt and shingles
 Loose, blown-in insulation, such as vermiculite
 Incandescent light fixture backing
- Roof gutters can be made of asbestos cement
- Artificial fireplace logs and ashes
- 6 Acoustic tiles
- Deck under-sheeting
- 8 Asbestos pad under the fireplace hearth

- 9 Pipe insulation
 10 Main panel and fuse box; each fuse wire has an individual asbestos flash guard
- 1 Door and gasket covers
- Backing behind recessed lighting
- Boiler and furnace insulation
- Asbestos can be found in stucco

- Soffit boards can be made of asbestos cement or asbestos insulating board
- Textured or stipple-coated walls and ceilings
- Asbestos cement (transite) board siding and undersheeting
- Outlets and switches
- Gypsum board filling compound, and patching and joint compound for walls and ceilings

- 20 Window putty
- Flooring: vinyl tiles and linoleum sheet flooring; flooring adhesive
- Downpipes can be made of asbestos cement
- Insulation on electrical wires
- Heat reflector for wood stove
